

Annotated Checklist of the Birds of Kentucky (3rd edition, 2019)
List of Corrections and Omissions

- p. 29: Mottled Duck – location of 30 Mar—7 Apr 2018 record should be McElroy Lake, not Fulton Co.
- p. 37: Black Scoter – *move* the unaccepted record of 24 on the Ohio River, Boyd Co., 3 Dec 2014 to be the first record in “Maximum counts” as the record should have been accepted.
- pp. 60-61: Purple Gallinule – *add* 19a) 28 May 2006, near Blue Spring, Trigg Co. (D. Gladis, eBird data).
- p. 70: Piping Plover – location of 29 Apr 2004 early spring date should be given as Union Co.
- p. 74: Marbled Godwit – *add* 17 Sep 2002 (2), Ohio River below Smithland Dam, Livingston Co. (KW 79:9, 2003; D. Roemer, eBird data).
- p. 150: Long-eared Owl – *correct mis-spelling* of “one”
- p. 160: Gray Kingbird – remove asterisk before species name (the species does not breed in KY)
- p. 174: Fish Crow – narrative states “Confirmed breeding actually has been documented on only a few occasions (see below).” Delete that sentence and replace with the following: “Despite a widespread presence across much of western Kentucky during the breeding season and numerous reports of possible or probable breeding, confirmed breeding has never been conclusively demonstrated by observation of an active nest or dependent young.”
- p. 194: Hermit Thrush – high count of 18 in McCreary County should be credited to S. Stedman [correction of spelling]
- p. 226: Western Meadowlark – *add* to Warren Co. (KW 81:61, 2005; D. Roemer, eBird data).
